## Trucking Around

Roundabouts are designed with a center truck apron to the left of the yellow line. This allows extra space for large vehicles to maneuver through the intersection by providing a place for the back wheels to ride.



Cars and smaller vehicles stay in the driving lane.

Some truck aprons may be beautified with different colors or patterns, but the apron still serves the purpose of allowing extra room for large vehicles.
