Amtrak Announces Return to *Missouri River Runner* Regular Schedule

JEFFERSON CITY – Track work on the Union Pacific Railroad tracks west of Jefferson City will be complete and the regular schedule of the Amtrak® *Missouri River Runner* trains 311, 314 and 316 will resume Oct. 10, ten days earlier than originally planned.

- **Train 311** which operates between St. Louis and Kansas City will depart at 9:15 a.m.
- **Train 313** which operates between St. Louis and Kansas City will depart at 4:00 p.m.
- **Train 314** which operates from Kansas City to St. Louis will depart at 8:15 a.m.
- **Train 316** which operates from Kansas City to St. Louis will depart at 4 p.m.
