


I-64 corridor construction 2013-2015



2013 CONSTRUCTION

1 I-64, Corridor lighting project - This project upgrades existing lighting along I-64 in St. Louis to tower-mounted lights between Kingshighway and the I-55 ramps on the PSB. Work should start in early 2013 and be complete by the end of the year.

2 I-64, Bridge replacement at Jefferson Avenue - This project will remove and replace the Jefferson Avenue Bridge over Interstate 64. This bridge will be built in the same location with a higher bridge clearance over the interstate to meet current Federal Highway standards. The new bridge will be wider and will have upgraded sidewalks, bike lanes and pedestrian ramps. Jefferson over I-64 will be closed for up to four months during construction. Work starts in early 2013, with a completion date of September 1.

3 I-64, Tower Grove and Boyle interchange project - MoDOT has partnered with Washington University Medical Center to improve the flow of traffic around Kingshighway and the east side of the medical campus. This project also includes bridges at Newstead and Taylor. Construction should start in January 2013 and be completed in summer 2014.

4 I-44 Park Over the Highway project - This project constructs the Park Over the Highway portion of improvements related to the Jefferson National Expansion Memorial Park. It includes work on Memorial Drive from the Illinois ramps to Washington Avenue and on future I-44 from the Poplar Street Bridge to Broadway. Construction is part of the CityArchRiver 2015 project.

5 Route 100 (Chouteau) pavement work - This project overlays the driving surface from the St. Louis City limits to Spring Avenue. The work also includes pedestrian improvements on the route. Work will start in early 2013 and be completed by fall 2013

2014 CONSTRUCTION

6 I-64 Poplar Street Bridge project - This project removes and replaces the ramps from the Poplar Street Bridge to the future eastbound I-44 and between the Poplar Street Bridge and I-55. This work will not start until the new Mississippi River Bridge opens.

7 I-64 Bridge rehabilitation - This project rehabilitates and overlays the bridge over Vandeventer Avenue. Work begins in summer 2014 and should be complete in early 2015.

2015 CONSTRUCTION

8 Route 100 (Chouteau) pavement work - This work removes and replaces the driving surface from Spring Avenue to I-55. The project also includes pedestrian improvements along the route. Work starts in spring 2015 and is finished in summer.
